BURSA MALAYSIA: Share Prices Open Broadly Lower In Early Trading

KUALA LUMPUR, Jan 31 (Bernama) -- Share prices on Bursa Malaysia opened broadly lower Monday, as the ripple effects of the Wall Street's sharp tumble on Friday spread to the region, dealers said.

At 9.15am, the FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI (FBM KLCI) fell 12.83 points to 1,509.06 after opening lower at 1,507.67.

He said finance, industrial, plantation and technology shares are expected to be weak as investors continued to dump stocks for safer assets like gold due to the uncertainties in Egypt.

The Finance Index lost 115.5 points to 13,847.6, the Industrial Index slid 19.27 points to 2,848.26, while the Plantation Index dwindled 46.84 points to 7,840.92.

The FBM Emas Index was 75.32 points lower at 10,412.23, the FBM70 Index shed 50.83 points to 11,201.32, while the FBM Ace Index slipped 21.26 points to 4,231.54.

Losers led gainers 264 to 38 while 104 counters were unchanged, 988 untraded and 46 suspended.

Volume stood at 81.031 million shares worth RM75.958 million.

Among active counters, newly listed Century Software gained five sen over its offer price of 93 sen with 104.254 million shares traded.

Karambunai was half a sen lower at 21 sen, Ho Wah Genting added half a sen to 64.5, while SAAG Consolidated was flat at 12 sen.

Of the heavyweights, Maybank was down eight sen to RM8.63, CIMB lost seven sen to RM8.38 and Sime Darby was two sen lower at RM9.14.

TA Global Bhd was suspended following its announcement that its subsidiary, Swiss Liberty Sdn Bhd, has inked an agreement with Kingdom Hotel Investments to buy the hotel and the business of Swissotel Kunshan in Kunshan, China, via the purchase of the entire issued shares of Kingdom Kunshan Ltd for US\$60.75 million. Trading will resume at 10.11am.

Ramunia Holdings Bhd, also suspended following Friday's announcement to acquire Pulau Indah Integrated Fabrication Yard from OilFab Sdn Bhd for RM83.8 million resumed trading at 10.11am today.

BURSA MALAYSIA: KL Shares Lower At Midday

KUALA LUMPUR, Jan 31 (Bernama) -- Share prices on Bursa Malaysia remained lower at midday Monday with profit taking activities seen in some heavyweights, but gains mostly in Axiata and Plus Expressways, managed to cap some of the losses.

Axiata gained five sen to RM4.78 while Plus Expressways rose two sen to RM4.41.

At lunch break, the FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI (FBM KLCI) lost 4.93 points to 1,516.96, after opening 14.22 points lower this morning at 1,507.67.

The Finance Index dwindled 52.92 points to 13,910.21, the Industrial Index shed 7.09 points to 2,861.44 and the Plantation Index went down 44.65 points to 7,843.11.

The FBM Emas Index was 37.8 points lower at 10,449.76, the FBM Ace Index lost 25.71 points to 4,227.09 and the FBM70 Index decreased 47.26 points to 11,204.89.

Losers led gainers 442 to 181 while 215 counters were unchanged, 556 untraded and 41 others suspended.

BURSA MALAYSIA: Shares Close Lower Despite Eleventh Hour Buying

KUALA LUMPUR, Jan 31 (Bernama)-- Share prices on Bursa Malaysia recovered some of its losses in eleventh hour buying but the FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI (FBM KLCI) still finished in the minus territory.

The market barometer closed 1.95 points easier at 1,519.94 after opening 14.22 points lower at 1,507.67.

A dealer said gains in Axiata, Genting, Maxis and Sime Darby managed to cap earlier losses.

Axiata advanced seven sen to RM4.80, Genting rose six sen to RM3.33, Maxis added two sen to RM5.34 while Sime Darby gained three sen to RM9.19.

Buying was also seen in properties, construction, industrial products and trade/services stocks with the key index trading between 1,505.85 and 1,520.63 points throughout the day.

A dealer said the local market, which remained in the red for most part of the day, saw range-bound trading as most investors were already away for the Chinese New Year holidays.

"Most likely, it is going to be quiet this week with only one-and-a-half- days of trading this week," HwangDBS Vickers Research said in its research note on Monday.

A sharp decline in overnight Wall Street and uncertainties in Egypt also made the local equities market less attractive.

The Finance Index fell 28.479 points to 13,934.65, the Plantation Index shed 19.03 points to 7,868.73 while the Industrial Index dipped 4.03 points to 2,863.5.

The FBM Emas Index fell 18.39 points to 10,469.17 and the FBM70 Index slipped 29.551 points to 11,222.6.

The FBM Ace Index, however, rose 39.45 points to 4,292.25.

Decliners outpaced advancers 428 to 300 while 280 were unchanged, 386 untraded and 41 others were suspended.

Volume rose to 1.415 billion shares, worth RM2.08 billion, from 1.347 billion shares, valued at RM1.976 billion, registered on Friday.

The market will be closed tomorrow for the Federal Territory Day and will resume trading on Wednesday for only half-a-day ahead of the Chinese New Year the next day.

Among most active stocks, Ho Wah Genting rose 8.5 sen to 72.5 sen, Hexagon-WA added 11.5 sen to 21 sen and Karambunai was flat at 21.5 sen.

Century Software, which debut on the Main Market on Monday, finished three sen higher at 96 sen, after opening at 94 sen, for a one sen premium with 20.26 million shares exchanging hands throughout the day.

CENTURY Software Holdings Bhd plans to double its share in the private sector market to 20 per cent by bidding for new contracts locally and abroad.

Currently, 90 per cent of the company's clients come from the public sector.

The group specialises in financial management software solutions.

"We have applied for a lot of tenders within the country and also abroad, but nothing has been finalised yet. Its still undergoing the approval process," executive director Abdul Mushir Che Chik said told reporters at the group's listing ceremony in Kuala Lumpur yesterday.

Century Software made its debut
